Collaborative Agreement to Create a Reciprocal Lectureship between "The Italian Chemical Society" and "The Korean Chemical Society"

In order to further develop scientific links between Italy and Republic of Korea the Italian Chemical Society (SCI) and the Korean Chemical Society (KCS) hereby agree to create a reciprocal invitational lectureship.

The lectureship is named: "Italian Chemical Society and Korean Chemical Society. "Ree-Natta Lectureship". The following is mutually agreed upon.

Preamble

SCI and KCS, which are the members of the leading European and Asian Chemical Societies, respectively, are pursuing the development of bilateral cultural agreements with germane Chemical Societies.

This bilateral agreement is aimed at strengthening the scientific collaboration between chemists of the two countries. On the basis of the proposed agreement named "*Ree-Natta Lectureship*", SCI will invite every two years a distinguished chemist from Republic of Korea and arrange a series of lectures (usually three) for him/her to deliver at prestigious Italian Universities or Research Laboratories. Generally, the invited lecturer will be selected from a shortlist of two or three names received from the partner Korean Chemical Society.

Similarly, on every other alternate year, the Korean Chemical Society will select a lecturer from a shortlist (two or three names) received from SCI and invite him/her to give three lectures in three different Universities or Research Institutions.

The Italian Chemical Society will cover the travel costs of the Italian lecturer visiting Korea and will also take care of the local costs of the Korean scientist visiting Italy. In the same way, the Korean Chemical Society will support the travel costs of its representative visiting Italy and will cover the local costs of the Italian scientist during his/her lecture trip in Korea.

There will be no restriction for the area of chemistry to be considered for granting the bilateral lectureship award.

The agreement can be revoked by either society with at least one-year advance notice, becoming effective at the end of the succeeding year.

The two societies may consider giving the lecturer a parchment with the statement of the lectureship and a plate with the lecturer's name, the date and the place where it is given. The two chemical societies agree to have the first event for "Ree–Natta Lectureship" in Korea for the Fall 2010.
